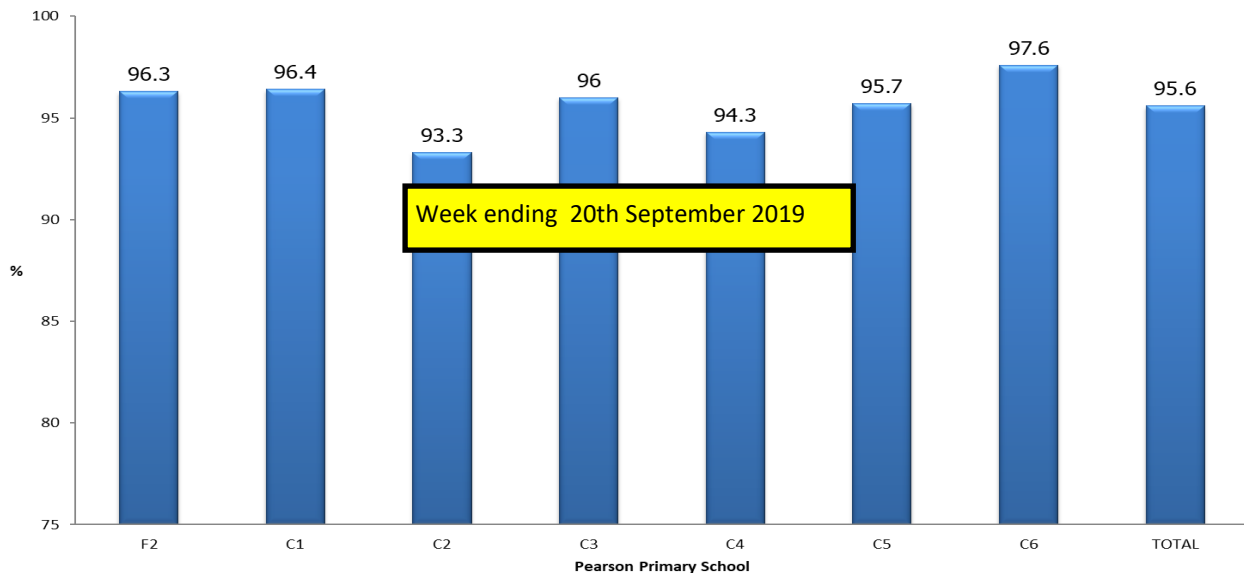

Our attendance target is 100%

Help your child be the best that they can by ensuring they come to school every day in their school uniform and on time.

Important Message About Attendance & Lateness

To enable our children to have the best possible education here at Pearson Primary School, we need the children to be at school every day and on time. This year we are **below** our attendance target set by the government and need your support to achieve our target. You can do this by ensuring:

- Children are not kept off school for minor illnesses/injuries
- Medical and dental appointments are made before or after school or during school holidays
 - Holidays are taken during school holidays

Please note that any holidays taken during term time will be an unauthorised absence. Any holiday absences in excess of 5 school days can result in a fine of £60 per child from the local government. If the fine is not paid within 22 days the fine will become £120.00 per child.
