


## Communication, language and literacy

During our daily interactions, we will develop our communication skills.

Through our **Read Write Inc.** sessions, we will develop our phonic knowledge to read individual letters & blend sounds into words. We will also be given lots of opportunities to write.

We will start to make up our own stories, and listen to lots of stories to develop our love of books. We will enjoy learning lots of new vocabulary.



## Maths

This half term we will continue to work with numbers to 10, we will be comparing groups, and finding one more and one less than a given number. We will begin to use different objects to represent amounts and start to add and subtract with numbers to 5.


Also we will look at 2D shapes, learning their names and using mathematical vocabulary to describe them.

## PSED

During our daily circles, we will listen to each other's thoughts and ideas. We will also talk about our feelings and how they can affect others.

After listening to the story of 'Goldilocks and The Three Bears' we will think about how to be a good friend.

**Our starting points for learning will be 'Goldilocks and The Three Bears' and 'Peace at Last'. We will also enjoy spending lots of time outside in our garden.**



## Understanding the world

This half term we will learn about the changes that happen during Autumn and Winter, and the creatures we might find. We will also investigate light and dark, and think about what happens during the day and night.

Near the end of the term, we will explore what is Christmas, and perform our own Christmas production!

## Physical development

This half term we will continue to develop our awareness of others through games. We will also develop our gross and fine motor skills through lots of activities and funky fingers.

During our P.E. sessions we will continue to practice getting dressed independently.

## Expressive arts and design

Our story 'Peace at Last' will provide us with lots of opportunities to make our own music. We will also be using the KAPOW scheme of work for our music lessons. During the half term we will use different techniques to make firework pictures, and we will also design and make a house for the three bears.

Our home corner will be turned into the three bear's cottage for us to take part in lots of role-play.
