Writing



This half term, we are focussing on writing a letter to Mrs Clarkson, a description of a puppy and a recount of a visit by a puppy!



Maths

We are focussing on measurements including time, shape and statistics in our build up to Year 2 SATs.



Reading

This term, we will be reading 'The Owl who was afraid of the Dark.' We will look at non-fiction texts that link to our history.

Science

We are continuing our learning on 'Plants' from last half term. We are observing plants over time and investigating to find out what plants need to grow.

Personal, Social, Health and Economics (PSHE)

The school's Jigsaw theme this half term is 'relationships'



This half term we will be looking at different types of families.

History

We are finding out about the lives of Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell. We are looking at why they are remembered today and compare their lives.



Design Technology

This half term we are using a running stitch in our unit on textiles. Our work will form part of a whole-school project!



Religious Education

We will be learning about 'Questions'. The key question that we will explore is: Who is God to people of faith?

We will look at the answer to this question for Christians and Muslims, and compare to the opinion of Humanists.

Computing

We are looking at different types of technology and how we keep ourselves safe online. We will learn to be respectful of technology and know who to ask for help if we need it.
